Theme:

The seminar aims at exploring, analyzing, and resolving disquiet prevailing in ethics concerning its theory, practice and methodology in our times. Ethics is a branch of philosophy that involves systematizing, defending, and recommending concepts of right and wrong conduct. In ethics, value denotes the degree of importance of some thing or action, with the aim of determining what actions are best to do or what way is best to live or to describe the significance of different actions. Values affect the ethical behavior of a person or are the basis of their intentional activities.

The seminar is an opportunity to offer students, teachers, and thinkers of official philosophy as well as non-philosophy to think critically about the complex ethical issues they confront in the contemporary techno-scientific world. This seminar is going to be a forum to understand and resolve some central dissatisfaction in normative ethics pertaining to its theories and its usefulness. The theoretical, practical and methodological disquiet is also reflected in applied ethics. It aims to trace and understand the reason of this disquiet and explores the possibilities for the resolution of this disquiet prevailing in handling issues in applied ethics. The seminar is expected to obtain multifaceted outcomes. These discussions and deliberations by academicians and experts from all corners of India during the two-day long periodical lecture and seminar will update and enrich the existing knowledge and understanding of normative ethics, meta-ethics and applied ethics. The seminar will come up with an inclusive set of ethical norms and considerations for understanding and resolving value-laden crises in the present-day world. It is also expected to open up more directions for future contemplations and researches in the various fields of contemporary ethics.

Call for Papers:

The seminar invites original and unpublished research papers for presentation from teachers, academicians, research scholars, and students. Research papers shall be subject to approval. All research papers shall be subject to the scrutiny of anti-plagiarism software. Selected papers may be published in an edited book with ISBN.

Guidelines for Submission of Abstract and Paper:

The interested participants are requested to send an abstract of 300 words within 22nd February 2020. Notification of acceptance or rejection of the abstract and paper will be sent to you within 3 working days via email. The abstract should be a summary of the research and is expected to meet the academic standards. On acceptance of the abstract, the author will be required to send in the full paper within 28th February 2020. Abstract and full paper should be submitted via email as an attachment in Microsoft Word format. Do not use abbreviations in the title. All abstracts and papers shall be arranged as:

Title of paper: Bold

Names of Author (s): First Name, Last Name.

Designation of Author

Institution Name

Keywords: Three to four words.

Text: **English (Times New Roman, font size 12)**

or

Bengali (Avro Keyboard, font size 16)

Line space: 1.5 spaces.

Margins: 1.1 inches on all sides.

Word count: Maximum 300 words for abstract and maximum 6000 words for paper.

Reference Style:

The reference list should appear at the end of the paper. Please include references of all materials you have cited throughout the paper in the order: Author (s) last name, First name (s) and year of publication, Title in the italics, Place of publication, Publisher, Page no. In the case of in-text citation, references should be listed in alphabetical order and all lines other than the first line should be indented.
