## The Preamble

Sahid Kshudiram with whose name the College is adorned was a great revolutionary. The tale of his life is written in the letter of gold in the annals of our struggle of freedom. He was born to Trailokya Nath Bose and Lakshmi Priya Debi at Moubani at Keshpur in the undivided historic District of Midnapore. Right from his infancy days he was brought up by his elder sister Anurupa Devi who bought him from her mother at the expense of handfuls of fragmented grains. This was a custom widely prevalent in rural Bengal to guarantee the survival of a male child in a family which witnessed pre-matured deaths. He lost his parents very early. He received his education first in Tamluk Hamilton High School and thereafter in Midnapore Collegiate School. However, he gave up his studies in his teen at the clarion of “Swadeshi Movement”. Bengal was then a boiling cauldron-it was all arms up against Lord Curzon, the typical British Imperialist who settled for the partition of Bengal in conformity with much professed “Divide and Rule” policy. The firebrand youths were not in a mood to offer passive resistance but championed the cause of militant nationalism. He became associated with such secret groups as Jugantar and Anushilan Samiti. The ideals of legendary nationalists like Aurobinda Ghosh, Brinadra Kumar Ghosh, Hemchandra Kanungo, Satyen Basu exerted much influence on him. At the time, Kingsford, the Presidency Magistrate, earned much notoriety as he used his position to inflict vehement torture on freedom fighters. In fact, he was despised with the nick name “Kaa Kaji”. Kshudiram Bose and Prafulla Chaki were entrusted with the task of annihilating Kingsford who was working as District Judge of Muzaffarpur. On 30<sup>th</sup> April, 1908 they hurled a bomb in order to kill Kingsford who was supposed to come out of Planters Night Club in horse-drawn carriage. Unfortunately, one Mrs. Kenedy and her daughter, both innocent Europeans, succumbed to injuries. Prafulla Chaki committed suicide to evade arrest. On the other hand, Kshudiram Bose was caught by the British Police. He was convicted and sentenced to death through hanging by the neck. The verdict was executed at dawn on 11<sup>th</sup> August, 1908. Thus, Kshudiram laid down his precious life to free his motherland from the shackles of the colonial rule. It beggars description that his martyrdom galvanized thousands of his countrymen in the war of independence. Even today when we talk of exemplary heroism, steely temperament, peerless patriotism and self-sublimating service, we drumbeat his name. Sahid Kshudiram defied death by virtue of his glorious deed, devotion and dedication. This institution of higher learning is a befitting tribute to the memory of an object lesson to one and all.

## The Genesis of Movement

Debra block was located almost in the heart of the undivided district of Midnapore . It was the fourth most populated area. Now a part of the Block borders on the District of Purba Medinipur. The communication network has also been very strong. Not only S.E. Railway line but also the National Highway No. 6. has crossed through the Block beside the P.W.D. pucca road. Because of the better amenities people of neighboring Blocks like Pingla, Sabong & Mayna have gathered and settled here. Though the main occupation of the inhabitant is agriculture and allied work, in course of time many have turned to industry, business & service. In keeping with their rising needs, hopes and aspirations, Primary, Secondary and Higher Secondary education expanded. But establishment of a college remained a remotereality . Right from late 1950 sporadic attempts have been made but to no effect. Mean while , the surrounding blocks have seen the blossoming of new colleges. In 1972, some land was made available at Gangaramchak Mouza in the form of donation. On 4<sup>th</sup> May, 1975 a big education convention was held, which toyed with various alternatives like polytechnic, General degree college, Agriculture Institution and Junior Basic Training College. The out come was inconclusive. With the introduction of 10+2+3 pattern in 1976 and independent non-integrated H.S. Institution named as Debra Uchchatar Madhyamik Vidyalaya (Known as Aurobinda College in the locality) was set up as stepping stone to higher education. Subsequently, it was resolved that the said institution will be upgraded in a degree college but no headway could be made. In early 1990, a fresh initiative was undertaken but it did not crystallize. Meanwhile, H.S sections were disintegrated from colleges. Therefore, setting up a degree college as a separate entity became a bare necessity. Against this backdrop , persons interested in education sat together and decided to form Debra Education and Development Society in 2005 . The Society immediately plunged in action. It is exhilarating to note that the Society's endeavour has borne fruit. The College got affiliation with Vidyasagar University in 2006 with due approval from the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of West Bengal.




## A Few Words About the Parent Society

Debra Thana Sahid Kshudiram Smriti Mahavidyalaya was established by DEEDS, a registered voluntary organization . The Society held a mammoth education convention on 4<sup>th</sup> September , 2005 in which people from various works of life enthusiastically took part . The foundation stone of the college was laid down on 17<sup>th</sup> November, 2005. The members of the Society with the support of Prof. Dipak Sarkar and the patronage of the Panchayat, M.P,M.L.A and the local administration left no stone unturned to collect resources from the general individuals and establishments. Almost all the properties created by the society for the college has been handed over to the secretary of the 1<sup>st</sup> Governing Body of the college after the formation on 4<sup>th</sup> Feb. 2011.

## Location

*The college is located beside Debra -Moyna/ Debra –Patashpur route, which is 3 km north to Balichak Railway Station (on S.E.Railway) 2 km South to Debra Bus stoppage (on National High Way No-6) from other side it is approachable by bus/ minibus/taxi/rickswa. It is a 10 minutes journey from Debra and 20 minutes journey from Balichak.*

## Additional rules regarding admission

- 1. Rules regarding admission to 1<sup>st</sup> Semester as laid down by the Department of Higher Education, West Bengal State Govt. & V.U will be strictly followed for online admission.*
- 2. Students who have passed Higher Secondary or equivalent examination with minimum 45% marks in the subject or related subject are eligible to apply for admission in the Honours course.*
- 3. Students carrying pass marks in at least five subjects are eligible to apply for admission in General course.*
- 4. Admission be done on Merit basis and Merit point for admission in Honours Course is to be calculated by adding 10% total marks obtained in the 'best five' subjects at Higher Secondary/ equivalent examination and the marks obtained in the subject or a related subject in which the admission in Honours Course is sought.*



*5. Merit point for admission in General Course is to be calculated by adding the marks obtained in 'best five' subjects at Higher Secondary/ equivalent examination.*

*6. For admission in General and Honours Course a student must secure pass marks passed in two language subjects of which one must be English at Higher Secondary/ equivalent examination.*

*7. If any student of Science stream at Higher Secondary/ equivalent examination applies for Honours Course in Bengali/ English / Hindi, his/ her merit point is to be calculated proportionately by deducting marks obtained in the practical examination .*

## ADMISSION CRITERIA

Admission criteria under CCFUP for 2023-24 and onwards shall be governed according to the guidelines issued by the Government of West Bengal and Debra Thana Sahid Kshudiram Smriti Mahavidyalaya as applicable from time to time. Proposed basic admission criteria applicable for UG Admission from the session 2024-25 are as follows:

- Candidates passing the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent board/council (as per Registered Board/ Council lists of Vidyasagar University) are eligible for admission in the undergraduate programmes with Single Major and Multidisciplinary Studies under CCFUP within three (03) consecutive academic sessions including the year of passing the qualifying examination.
- Candidate must have passed in 4 (Four) recognized subjects including at least one language subject (excluding Environmental Education / Studies) including at least one language subject in the qualifying examination.
- Students who have passed Higher Secondary or equivalent examination with a minimum of 45% marks in the Aggregate (to be calculated by adding the marks obtained in 'Best Four' subjects including at least one language subject excluding Environmental Education/Studies) along with pass in the subject/related subject or 50% marks in the subject or related subject are eligible to apply for admission in the Single Major (Honours/Honours with Research) programmes.
- Students carrying pass marks in Higher Secondary (10+2) or equivalent examinations with at least a pass in four subjects including at least one language subject (excluding Environmental Education/Studies) are eligible to apply for Multidisciplinary programmes under CCFUP.
- Candidates passing the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) from the Vocational stream conducted by the respective Board/ Council for vocational studies or any other equivalent board/council are eligible for admission within Four (04) consecutive academic sessions including the year of passing the qualifying examination in the undergraduate programmes in Multidisciplinary Studies only fulfilling the other criteria.
- All admission to the 1st Semester of the undergraduate programme of studies is subject to Merit calculation and availability of seats in a particular 'Major Subject' for a 4-year Honours / Research programme and seats available in a particular field of studies for a 3-year Multidisciplinary programme.
- All admission processes to the First Semester in the affiliated Degree Colleges shall be completed according to the guidelines of the Government of West Bengal and/or the Academic Calendar of each Academic year of Debra Thana Sahid Kshudiram Smriti Mahavidyalaya as applicable from time to time.

## CALCULATION OF MERIT POINT

- ✓ Admission be done on a merit basis and merit points for admission in a 4-Year Bachelor's with Honours programme are to be calculated by adding 10% of total marks obtained in the Best of Four subjects including at least one language subject excluding Environment Education/Studies at Higher Secondary / Equivalent examination and the marks obtained in the subject or related subject in which the admission in honours course is sought.
- ✓ Merit points for admission in a 3-year Bachelor's in Multidisciplinary Studies is to be calculated by adding the marks obtained in the Best of Four subjects including at least one language subject excluding Environmental Education/Studies of Higher Secondary /equivalent examinations.
- ✓ If any student of the Science stream in Higher Secondary /equivalent examination applies for Honours in Bengali /English /Hindi, his /her merit point is to be calculated proportionately by deducting marks obtained in the practical examination.
